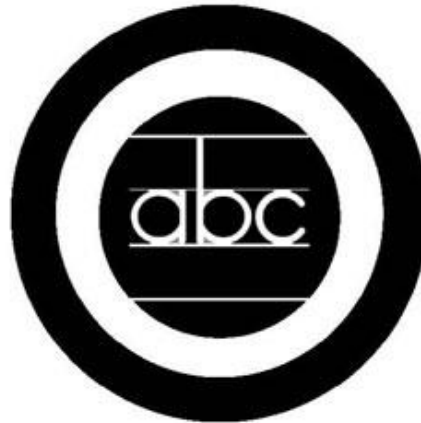

School college readiness.

Law Academy: Two year

Mock Trial: Interscholastic

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Lawyers in the Schools: Legal theme projects administered by attorney volunteers.

Day in Court: Students witness trials and engage in Q & A with Superior Court judge and attorney volunteers.



Mock trial

- 61% of the students agreed when asked if they joined the mock trial program because they were interested in becoming a lawyer.
- 96% agreed that the mock trial program helped them build their confidence.
- 100% believe mock trial will help prepare them for college.

School to College (STC)

In 2012, 88% of STC graduates went onto a 4-year school, as compared to just 37% of students not enrolled in the program.
